

COVINGTON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF POLICE PENSION PLAN AMENDMENTS
ORDINANCE 2020-03
JULY 28, 2020

The Covington Township Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing on Tuesday July 28, 2020 at 6:10 p.m., at the Covington Township Pavilion Building, Moffat Estate, 20 Moffat Drive, Covington Township, PA for a hearing on Police Pension Plan Amendments Ordinance.

There were present: John Brostoski, Vice Chairman; Joseph Setta, Supervisor; William Fells, Supervisor; Melissa Kearney, Supervisor; Douglas A Hein, Secretary / Treasurer and Joel M. Wolff, Esquire. Also present were David Lamm, Building Inspector; and Ronald Donati, Zoning. Thomas M. Yerke, Chairman was not present.

The hearing was opened Mr. Brostoski.

Mr. Brostoski turned the hearing over to Solicitor Wolff to begin.

Mr. Wolff entered the Township exhibits as follows:

Mr. Wolff noted there was no public present (besides Mr. Lamm and Mr. Donati) to offer any comment or objections. Mr. Wolff stated he had been on a teleconference a few month ago with PMRS representatives, Chairman Yerke, Supervisor Kearney and past Secretary Kate Tierney to determine what was changing in the pension plan. PMRS stated nothing was changing other than what options the Township had chosen and they were holding the teleconference to confirm the choices for their records. Supervisor Kearney agreed.

Supervisor Brostoski called a vote; motion carried 4-0 to pass Ordinance 2020-03.
