#### There are two types of zoning permits:

- 1. Structure permits: for signs, fences, sheds, decks, satellite dishes, swimming pools, outdoor furnaces, etc.
- 2. Use Permits: this permit allows a property owner to use his or her property in a certain way. For example, a person may apply for a permit to build a garage on their property. However, approval of the structure does not allow the property owner to "use "the garage in a commercial capacity. To use the garage as a business location, the property owner must obtain a use permit.

## What types of buildings require permits?

- 1. Single Family Residence
- 2. Accessory Buildings such as a detached garage and sheds
- 3. Multi-Family Residences and Commercial Structures
- 4. Existing structures that will be renovated or expanded.

## What must be submitted with Zoning Permit application?

- 1. Approved driveway/highway occupancy permit
- 2. Approved sewer permit
- 3. Plot plan showing structures, proposed and existing, and distances from lot line.
- 4. Floor plans showing intended use of each room.
- 5. Valid agreement of sale or deed if owned less than two years.
- 6. Application fee Residential \$50.00 + \$0.04 per square foot Non-Residential application fee \$ \$100.00 plus \$0.08 per square foot
- 7. A check or money order payable to Covington Township

Once your zoning permit is approved, you may fill out an application for a Building Permit.

## What must be submitted with a Building Permit application?

- 1. Four copies of construction drawings including architectural, mechanical, plumbing and electrical. See attached application and fee guidelines.
- 2. Four copies of plot plans showing structures, proposed and existing, and distance from lot lines.
- 3. Four copies of building plans including floor plan listing with intended use of each room
- 4. Certificate of insurance from your contractor
- 5. Building Permit application must be notarized.
- 6. Fee will be determined after review of application.

# Covington Township Required Construction Permits

Prior to obtaining a building or zoning permit, you must first apply for a Sewage Permit.

\*SEWAGE: KBA Engineering, PC (570) 876-5744 Sewage Enforcement if on site

### What must be submitted with a Sewage Permit application?

- 1. If it is an on-lot system, your property MUST be tested and perked.
- 2. A septic design provided with assistance from the Sewage Enforcement officer.
- 3. Fee will be determined in accordance to attached fee schedule.
- 4. If it is a central sewer system, you must contact the Covington Township Sewer Authority and pay the appropriate hook up costs.

Once your sewer permit is approved you may apply for both Driveway/Highway Occupancy and Zoning Permits.

**★ Driveways**: Driveway permits are required for all driveways.

If a driveway is off a township road contact:

- Two sets of plans detailing location and pertinent dimensions of the proposed installation 30 days prior to the anticipated start of work.
- A check or money order payable to Covington Township (see attached fee schedule)

### When do you need a Zoning Permit?

- ♦ When you build a new structure on your property or enlarge an existing structure.
- ♦When you erect a new sign or change the size or content of an existing sign.
- ♦When you erect a fence, install a satellite dish greater than 3', install an outdoor wood burner or install an in ground or above ground swimming pool.
- ♦When you change the use of or start a new use on a property.
- ♦When you replace a mobile home.
