

ORDINANCE 2024-01

COVINGTON TOWNSHIP
LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 2005-01 (ORIGINALLY
ORDINANCE NO. 2003-06)

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Covington Township, Lackawanna County, (the "Township"), passed an Ordinance (No. 2005-01, originally Ordinance No. 2003-06) imposing a tax on admissions to amusements; establishing the rates of taxation and requiring payment of tax due; requiring permit, fee, and application; establishing the expiration date thereof; establishing the duties of the designated tax collector; requiring a confidential return; and prescribing penalties for violations;

WHEREAS, the Township has never issued permits, collected monies or fees, or imposed fines for this Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Township now desires to repeal Ordinance No. 2005-01, originally Ordinance No. 2003-06, imposing a tax on admissions to amusements; establishing rates of taxation and requiring payment of tax due; requiring permit, fee, and application; establishing the expiration date thereof; establishing the duties of the designated tax collector; requiring a confidential return; and prescribing penalties for violations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Covington Township, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania that the Ordinance of the Township, No. 2005-01 (originally Ordinance No. 2003-06) imposing the amusement tax, is hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.
