

COVINGTON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
SPECIAL MEETING
JUNE 30, 2026

The Covington Township Board of Supervisors held a special meeting on Tuesday, June 30, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. at the Covington Township Municipal building, Moffat Estate, 20 Moffat Drive, Covington Township, PA 18444. Chairwoman Kearney opened the meeting at 6:30 p.m. with the Pledge to the Flag.

Present: Chairwoman Melissa A. Kearney, Vice-Chairman F. Marshall Peirce (via telephone), Supervisor William Beavers, and Attorney Joel Wolff.

Absent: Supervisor William Willson and Supervisor Wanda Andreoli

Chairwoman Kearney announced the purpose of this special meeting was to advertise the intent to appoint a CPA (certified or competent public accountant). She also verified with the public that everyone in attendance could hear Vice-Chairman Peirce on the phone; all (4) public attendees answered yes.
